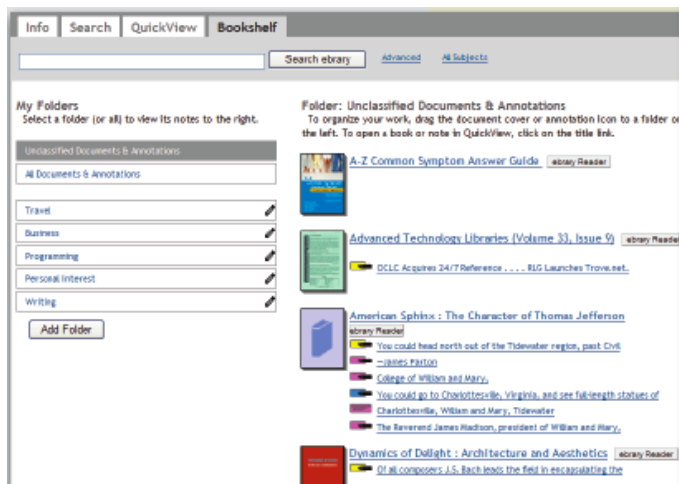
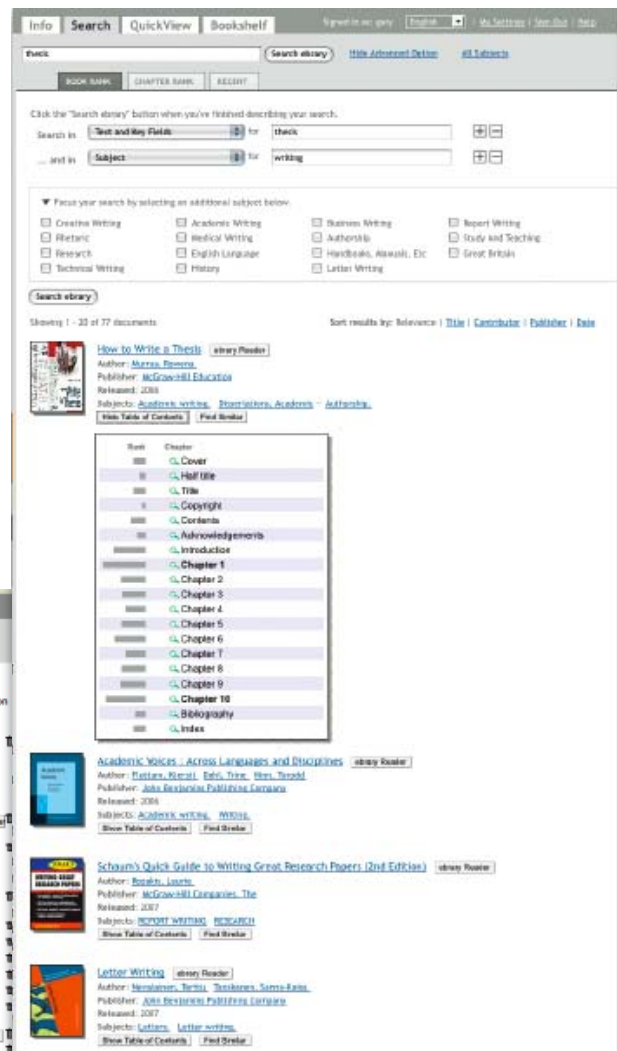
**ebrary** is a full-text collection of over 42,900 books covering all subjects from the world's leading publishers, plus special technology to help you effectively use these online books for research. Over 1/3 of the books are published 2004 and after.

Starting on Wednesday, January, 21, 2009, we are pleased to announce a new User Interface (UI) that provides you with a wealth of new and enhanced capabilities.

As part of the new UI, ebrary offers a number of options for viewing the content. Users may choose to use the ebrary Plug-in Reader™, or the ebrary QuickView™. A comparison of the different Readers is available on the opposite page of this fact sheet.

### Additional key features of our new UI include the following:

- Numerous search enhancements including:
  - Chapter ranking of search results
  - Additional search fields (Dewey Decimal, LC, ISBN, publication year, document language, and more)
  - Simple search on every page
  - Focus search by subject
  - Find similar function added to search results
  - Search history for the current session
  - Searching in multiple languages simultaneously for multiple content types
- Bookshelves with movable folders that can store documents as well as single annotations
- Enhanced help (Top Right of Page)

With ebrary, you can customize viewing options to meet your individual needs under "**My Settings**" located in the upper right hand corner of the page.

We offer ebrary *QuickView*, which allows instant viewing in a browser, as well as our *Plug-in Reader*, which offer greater functionality to enhance the research experience.

Many of our end-users prefer to use *QuickView* to peruse a document, then launch the *Plug-in Reader* to print, copy text, highlight, use ebrary InfoTools™ and more.

All ebrary Readers are offered in conjunction with our new and improved user interface, which is described on the opposite page of this fact sheet.
